

ORDINANCE 1424

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, AMENDING THE PAYETTE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 2.48.020 AMENDING THE TERM OF APPOINTMENT; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; ALLOWING PUBLICATION IN SUMMARY FORM; ESTABLISHING SEVERABILITY; ESTABLISHING A REPEALER; PROVIDING A PENALTY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

Section 1. Section 2.48.020 of Title 2, Chapter 2.48 of the Payette Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.48.020: APPOINTMENT; VACANCY FILLING; COMPENSATION:

A. For the government of the public library, there shall be a board of five (5) library trustees appointed by the mayor and approved by the city council from among the citizens that reside and continuously maintain their residency within the city of Payette. Such trustees shall hold their office for five (5) years from the date of appointment and until their successors are appointed. **The term of each Trustee shall end December 31st of the fifth year after appointment.** Each year, the city council shall appoint one of its members to be a liaison to the board, but he/she will have no voting rights.

B. Any vacancy on the board shall be reported to the mayor within five (5) days by its trustees, and shall be filled by appointment in the same manner as appointments are originally made. Appointments to complete an unexpired term shall be for the remainder of the term only. Vacancies automatically occur when a board member moves out of the city limits, dies or their term expires.

C. No compensation shall be paid or allowed to any trustee other than being reimbursed for expenses incurred which were previously approved by the city council for library related activities. (Ord. 1239 § 1, 2005; Ord. 1109 § 2, 1995; prior code § 2-2-2)

Section 2. This Ordinance may be published in summary form allowed by Idaho Code.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by the laws of the State of Idaho.

Section 4. Any ordinances or resolutions which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, but only insofar as the conflict exists.

Section 5. If any portion of this Ordinance should be found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall be applied to effectuate the purposes of this Ordinance.


Section 6. Any violation of this ordinance shall be a misdemeanor.
