

RESOLUTION NO. 2011-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, ADOPTING AND SETTING CERTAIN FEES AT THE PAYETTE MUNICIPAL POOL.

WHEREAS, the Payette City Council sets fees for recreational programs offered by the City of Payette, including the Payette Municipal Pool; and,

WHEREAS, rates at the pool have not been raised in the last two years; and,

WHEREAS, the Council held a Public Hearing on April 4, 2011 and has reviewed the current swimming pool fees and determined that an increase in fees is needed to offset the rising operation costs and to increase the financial self-sufficiency of the Payette Municipal Swimming Pool.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

Section 1: The following fees are hereby adopted and those fees shall be charged by the Payette Municipal Pool:

Pool Passes:

Age 18-63


1 Year resident	\$200.00
1 Year non-resident	\$260.00

Re: Pool fee increase

BACKGROUND & JUSTIFICATION: The City of Payette held a public hearing on increasing pool rates in October 2010. When the rates were presented there was an over site on pool passes ages 18-63. The amounts were actually reduced from \$180.00 to \$140.00 for residents and \$240.00 to \$170.00 for non-residents. The correct amounts should have been 1 year resident - \$200.00 and 1 year non-resident \$260.00.

FISCAL IMPACT: \$20.00 per pass sold

RECOMMENDATION: Recommend that City Council approve the pool pass rates for ages 18-63 for a 1 year resident pass - \$200.00 and a 1 year non-resident pass for \$260.00.
