WHEREAS, the City of Payette has several pieces of equipment and property that have exceeded their useful life and no longer serve the needs of the City of Payette, and,


WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Mayor and City Council to declare the equipment and property as surplus, and,

WHEREAS, the equipment and property will be dismantled for useful spare parts, and computer memories wiped clean of City information and disposed of.


