WHEREAS, the City of Payette has several pieces of equipment and property that have exceeded their useful life and no longer serve the needs of the City of Payette, and,


WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Mayor and City Council to declare the equipment as surplus, and,

WHEREAS, the equipment will be dismantled for useful spare parts, and disposed of.



BACKGROUND & JUSTIFICATION: The Street/Park Departments have a 1968 bucket truck that they would like to have declared as surplus and scrapped. We have purchased a newer bucket truck in this budget year. The old truck is not safe. State Code mandates public property be declared surplus before being sold or destroyed.

FISCAL IMPACT: The revenue generated from the sale of scrap metal will be credited to the street/park department.

RECOMMENDATION: Recommend that City Council approve Resolution #2013-11 to declare as surplus the 1968 bucket truck and it be scrapped.
