IDAHO POLICING POLICY MANUAL
FOR THE CITY OF PAYETTE AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, the City of Payette, has sought to develop policies and memorialize them in writing so that they may serve as guidelines for the operation of the City and its employees and provide for successful and efficient function of the City of Payette; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council previously approved the Idaho Policing Policy Manual and subsequent supplement on March 18, 2020; and,

WHEREAS, due to recent changes with minor edits to improve clarity, it is necessary to update the Idaho Policing Policy Manual (See Attached Update Changes), and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Mayor and City Council to adopt and approve the Idaho Policing Policy Manual and Supplement updated 2020; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Payette, that the Idaho Policing Policy Manual is hereby approved and adopted for the City of Payette, Idaho, effective August 14, 2020.



POLICY CHANGE RECORD

June 2020

UPDATED

Minor edits to improve clarity were made to the following sections: Personal Conduct – On or Off Duty, Interference with Prosecution; Search and Seizure, Miranda; Arrest and Custody; Juvenile Procedures; ILETS; and Confidential Informants.

Use of Force and Weapons

- Replaced “avoidance and de-escalation” with the contemporary words “time, distance and communication”
- Clarified that displaying or drawing a weapon requires reasonable cause
- Defined imminent threat
- Provided additional emphasis re: not to shoot at or from a moving vehicle
- Change name of conducted energy “device” to “weapon”
- Clarified language re: stop use of chemical weapons if not effective

Hate Crimes (added “national origin”)

Sexual Assault Kits (added recommendation to consult with your prosecutor to ensure compliance with state law)

Photo Line-ups (added a statement to contact your supervisor or prosecutor before administering a photo line-up)
