**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO,
DECLARING SUPPORT AND ADOPTION OF THE
PAYETTE COUNTY MULTI-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN**

WHEREAS, hazard mitigation planning is the process of developing a set of actions designed to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people, businesses, infrastructure, and property from hazards and their effects; and,

WHEREAS, the U.S. Congress passed the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 ("Disaster Mitigation Act") made available hazard mitigation grants to state and local governments emphasizing the need for pre-disaster mitigation of potential hazards; and,

WHEREAS, an adopted Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan is required as a condition for future funding for mitigation projects under multiple FEMA pre- and post-disaster mitigation grant programs; and,

WHEREAS, the Idaho Department of Emergency Management and the Federal Emergency Management Agency officials have reviewed the "Payette County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan", and approved it contingent upon this official adoption of the participating governing bodies; and,

WHEREAS, The City of Payette desires to comply with the requirements of the Disaster Mitigation Act and to augment its emergency planning efforts by formally adopting the Payette County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan; and,

WHEREAS, adoption by the governing body of the City of Payette demonstrates the City's commitment to fulfilling the mitigation goals and objectives outlined in this Multi-Hazard Plan; and,

WHEREAS, adoption of this resolution legitimizes the plan and authorizes responsible agencies to carry out their responsibilities under the plan.




