

ORDINANCE NO. 385

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 329 OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR RAISING A REVENUE BY PLACING A LICENSE ON VARIOUS KINDS OF AMUSEMENTS, BUSINESS AND PROFESSIONS AND REQUIRING A LICENSE OF PEDDLERS, HAWKERS, DRAYMEN, CONFECTIONERY DEALERS, AUCTIONEERS, BILL POSTERS, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF," BY INSERTING THEREIN IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING CLASS 22 OF SECTION 4 THEREOF, A NEW CLASS DESIGNATED AS CLASS 23, AND WHICH SHALL READ AS FOLLOWS:

CLASS 23. Each and every person, firm or corporation who shall construct, operate or maintain a minature golf link within the City of Payette, Idaho, shall pay a license fee of \$10.00 per quarter.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
