

ORDINANCE NO. 402

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 400, BEING AN AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 396, LIMITING THE TIME WHEN BEER MAY BE SOLD, CONSUMED OR DISPOSED OF WITHIN THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCILMEN OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

SECTION 1. That Section 7 of Ordinance No. 396, as passed by the City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho, and approved by the Mayor of said city on the 7th day of August, 1933, and as amended by Ordinance No. 400 as passed by the City Council of said city and approved by the mayor of said city on the 17th day of December, 1934, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 7. It shall be unlawful for any retailer to suffer or permit any person under the age of 18 years to consume any beer as defined in this ordinance, in or upon his premises, or for any retailer to sell, give away or in anywise dispose of any such beer to any person under the age of 18 years; or for any retailer to sell, give away or dispose of any such beer or to permit any such beer as defined in this ordinance to be consumed by any person in or upon his premises at any time between the hours of one o'clock, A. M., and six o'clock, A. M."

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
