

ORDINANCE NO. 405

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A CITY PLANNING COMMISSION, PROVIDING FOR RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE GOVERNMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF SAID PLANNING COMMISSION; PROVIDING FOR THE POWERS, DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS OF SAID PLANNING COMMISSION, AND FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE EXPENSES OF SAID COMMISSION.

THE CITY OF PAYETTE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby created a City Planning Commission for the City of Payette, Idaho, which commission shall be known and designated as the City of Payette Planning Commission.

Section 2. Said City Planning Commission shall consist of the Mayor and City Attorney, ex-officio, and seven other members to be appointed by the Mayor, at least one of whom shall be a qualified civil engineer. All of the members shall be residents and taxpayers of the City of Payette, Idaho, except that one member may be appointed from without the city limits. At the first meeting of the City Planning Commission the seven appointed members shall choose their term of office by allotment as follows:

Two for two years
Two for four years
Three for six years

and shall immediately thereafter notify the Mayor and City Council of such allotment. Thereafter their successors shall be appointed for and shall hold office for a term of six (6) years. In the event of the death, resignation or any vacancy in said commission the Mayor is hereby authorized and empowered to fill such vacancy by appointment for the unexpired term of such member or members.

Section 3. The City Planning Commission shall at its first meeting elect a President and a Vice-President, who shall be members appointed by the Mayor, and who shall hold office during the pleasure of the commission.

Section 4. Members of the City Planning Commission shall receive no compensation. The City Planning Commission shall elect a Secretary who need not be a member of the Commission.

Such secretary shall keep an accurate record of all proceedings of said Commission and the Commission shall on the first Monday of May of each year make and file with the City Council a report of all transactions of the Commission. The Commission shall hold meetings at least once during each calendar month, and at such other times as may be necessary.

Section 5. It shall be the duty of the City Planning Commission to study economic, social, and physical conditions of the City of Payette, and to recommend and make suggestions to the City Council and to all other public authorities concerning the laying out, widening, extending, parking and locating the streets, sidewalks, and boulevards, the establishment of set-back lines, the relief of traffic congestion, the betterment of housing and sanitation conditions and the establishment of zones and districts limiting the use, height, area and bulk of buildings and structures; to recommend to the City Council, and all other public authorities, plans for the regulations of the future growth, development and beautification of the municipality in respect to its public and private buildings and works, streets, parks, grounds and vacant lots, and plans consistent with the future growth and development of the city in order to secure the city and its inhabitants, sanitation, proper service of all public utilities, and transportation facilities, and in general to study and to propose such measures as may be advisable for the promotion of the public interest, health, morals, safety, comfort, convenience and welfare of said city, and of the area for five miles adjacent thereto.

Section 6. All Departments and employees of the city are hereby instructed to cooperate with, and furnish to the City Planning Commission, maps, reports, and all available data necessary for the Commission to properly and adequately carry out its functions. The Planning Commission is also authorized to appoint such technical and advisory committees as are necessary to carry out its work, and to call upon the citizens of the community, and the various civic organizations for cooperation and assistance to the end that a coordinated program of city planning may be promoted.


Section 7. All matters pertaining to the planning, laying out, and the development and construction of public works shall be submitted to the City Planning Commission for its study and recommendations before being presented to the City Council. The various Departments of the City Government in submitting plans and recommendations to the Council, are hereby required to furnish copies in full duplicate to the City Planning Commission.

Section 8. Nothing in this ordinance shall be construed as infringing upon the authority previously granted to any existing city commission or board but provides that such commissions or boards shall coordinate their efforts with the City Planning Commission to the end that a more comprehensive plan of city development may be evolved.

Section 9. The City Planning Commission shall have no authority to make expenditures on behalf of the City nor to obligate the City for the payment of any sums of money unless authorized by an ordinance which shall contain the administrative method by which such funds shall be expended.
