

ORDINANCE NO. 415

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING AND LICENSING CERTAIN
MACHINES AND THE OPERATORS THEREOF, AND PROVIDING
A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF SAID ORDINANCE.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette,
Idaho:

Section 1.- The word "machine" as used in this ordinance shall mean and include every machine and/or device and/or apparatus of whatsoever kind, nature or description, operated by the use of coins, merchandise tokens, slugs or chips, when wholly or partially as a result of skill on the part of the person playing the same, prizes, premiums, checks, money or other tokens of value are offered or given by the owner or person maintaining and/or operating the same, either directly or automatically by such machine.

The word "operator" as used herein shall mean any person, firm or corporation operating a place of business in Payette and maintaining therein any such machine where the same may be played by the public, and also any person, firm or corporation maintaining any such machine in Payette where the same may be played by the public.

Section 2.- It shall be unlawful for any operator to maintain any such machine in Payette where the same may be played by the public without having first paid the license fees and procured the licenses therefor as herein provided.

Section 3.- Every operator shall pay a license fee of \$18.00 per quarter year, or fraction thereof, for every such machine maintained at any place in Payette where the same may be played by the public. A change of machine shall be permissible under said license, that is, the licensee shall be permitted to maintain the number of machines designated in said license and may change such machines about, at no time maintaining a greater number of machines than covered by such license.

Section 4.- The City Clerk shall issue licenses for all such machines licensed as above provided, which said licenses shall be publicly displayed where such machines are maintained.

Section 5.- It shall be unlawful to maintain, keep or operate on any premises in Payette any such machine in condition and position so that the same may be operated, played or used by the public, unless license therefor has first been issued as provided in this ordinance and is publicly displayed on said premises. It shall be unlawful for the owner, licensee or person in charge of any place or premises in the City of Payette to permit the use or operation of any such machines on said premises unless such machine has been licensed hereunder and the license is displayed on said premises.

Section 6.- It shall be unlawful for any person to allow any such machine then in his possession or under his immediate charge to be played or operated by any minor under the age of eighteen years, and the proprietor of any place of business wherein any such machine is operated or displayed shall be conclusively presumed to be the one in possession and control thereof.

Section 7.- No license shall be issued hereunder for any machine as herein defined which is prohibited in operation by the laws of the State of Idaho, or by the ordinances of the City of Payette relative to gambling and/or slot machines.

Section 8.- Every license issued hereunder shall be issued on a quarterly-year basis with quarters ending May 31, August 31, November 30, and February 28, and full quarterly license shall be charged for a fraction of a quarter.


Section 9.- Every person violating any provision or requirement of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof before the Police Judge of the City of Payette, be fined in a sum not to exceed \$100.00.

This ordinance shall take effect on August 31, 1936 and after its passage, approval and publication.
