ORDINANCE NO 424

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO 379 PASSED AND APPROVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, ON AUGUST 19, 1929, BY ADDING A NEW SECTION THERETO, TO BE KNOWN AS SECTION 16-A, PROHIBITING THE OPERATION OF VEHICLES WITHIN THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, WHILE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR, OR NARCOTIC DRUGS, AND PROVIDING PENALTY THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED, By the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

That a New Section be added to Ordinance No.379 of the City of Payette, Idaho, to be designated as Section 16-A, and reading as follows:

Section 16-A.- It shall be unlawful and punishable, as provided by Ordinance No 379 of the City of Payette, Idaho, for any person, who is under the influence of intoxicating liquor or of narcotic drugs, to drive any vehicle, as defined in Ordinance No.379, upon any highway, street or alley within the City of Payette, Idaho.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
