

ORDINANCE NO. 475

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 7 OF ORDINANCE 390 RELATING TO THE TRAINING OF FIREMEN AND AMENDING SECTION 10 OF ORDINANCE 390 FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF FIREMEN; AND ADDING A NEW SECTION TO ORDINANCE 390 PROVIDING THAT THE CITY COUNCIL, IN MAKING PURCHASE OF FIRE DEPARTMENT EQUIPMENT, SHALL OBTAIN THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE MEMBERS OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT BEFORE MAKING SUCH PURCHASES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

Section 1. That Section 7 of Ordinance 390 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 7. All general firemen shall be trained to handle any and all the fire apparatus provided; also to act in any desired capacity in handling first aid fire apparatus, hose, chemical engines or doing salvaging work. They shall do everything within their power to get the fire under control, to remain at their posts of duty unless excused by the commanding officer and to return with the apparatus from fires, alarms or drills to the fire station.

Any firemen leaving town for some time shall inform the fire chief immediately and obtain a leave of absence.

Section 2. That Section 10 of Ordinance 390 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 10. Compensation. Each member in good standing in the department shall receive from the City of Payette, as full compensation for his labor at the end of each quarter, the amount to which he is entitled, which shall be based upon the number of runs he actually participated in; and the compensation for each run shall be as follows: for day runs, between the hours of 8 o'clock A.M. and 8 o'clock P.M. -- regular runs -- \$2.50 per run, which shall include the first hour or any part thereof on duty at fire.

Overtime to begin at the end of first hour on duty at fire, \$1.00 per hour.

Night runs, \$3.75 per run, which includes the first hour or any part thereof on duty at fire.

Overtime, which shall begin at the end of first hour on duty at fire, \$1.50 per hour.

Day runs, \$2.50 per run.

One business and one practice meeting shall be held during each month, or the council may order additional meetings or drills and each member shall be allowed One Dollar(\$1.00) as compensation for each meeting or drill he attends.

Section 5. That a new section be added to Ordinance 390 to be designated as Section 10A, and to follow Section 10, and to read as follows:

Section 10A. Council to Obtain Recommendation of Department Members on Purchasing Equipment. Purchase of equipment for the Fire Department shall be made by the City Council, provided, however, that before purchasing any equipment the Council shall obtain the recommendation of the members of the Fire Department, which recommendation shall be presented by the Chief of the Fire Department or other delegated representative.
