ORDINANCE NO. 482

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE 394 DEFINING THE TERM "ITINERANT MERCHANT" SO AS TO EXCLUDE FROM SUCH DEFINITION THE MAKING OR SELLING OR OFFERING FOR SALE PHOTOGRAPHS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

Section 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance 394 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. The term "itinerant merchant" as used in this act shall mean and include any transient person who shall engage temporarily in the selling or offering for sale of any goods, wares or merchandise, within the City of Payette regardless of whether such goods, wares or merchandise are peddled from house to house, or store to store or sold upon the streets or other public places or sold from room, building, structure or lot rented or leased for the purpose of carrying on such business, and also any person who brings goods, wares or merchandise into the city and opens a temporarily place of business for the exhibition or sale thereof and who shall not have paid a tax thereon within Payette County, Idaho.
