

ORDINANCE NO. 488

AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR ANY "CLUB", AS THE WORD 'CLUB' IS DEFINED BY SUB-SECTION "B" OF SECTION 2 OF CHAPTER 112 OF THE 1945 SESSION LAWS OF THE STATE OF IDAHO, TO CONDUCT OR OPERATE ANY "COIN OPERATED AMUSEMENT DEVICE" AS DEFINED BY SUB-SECTION "A" OF SECTION 2 OF SAID CHAPTER 112, AND REQUIRING ANY SUCH "CLUB" OPERATING A "COIN OPERATED AMUSEMENT DEVICE" COMMONLY CALLED SLOT MACHINES, TO PAY A LICENSE OF \$50 PER YEAR ON EACH SUCH MACHINE; PROVIDING FOR THE FILING OF APPLICATIONS AND THE ISSUING OF SUCH LICENSE BY THE CITY CLERK, AND FIXING A PENALTY FOR THE OPERATION BY OR USE IN ANY SUCH "CLUB" OF ANY SUCH "COIN OPERATED AMUSEMENT DEVICE" WITHOUT A LICENSE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

Section 1. That it shall be and is hereby declared to be unlawful for any "Club" as the word "Club" is defined by Sub-section "B" of Section 2 of Chapter 112 of the 1945 Session Laws of the State of Idaho, to own, conduct or operate any "Coin Operated Amusement Device" as such device is defined by Sub-section "A" of Section 2 of said Chapter 112, unless such "club" or some person on its behalf, shall apply to the City Clerk of the City of Payette, Idaho, for and receive a license and pay the license fees as in this Ordinance prescribed. In such application the applicant shall recite the ownership of such amusement devices, and each of them operated in such "Club", and a brief description of the type and serial number of each such device. Likewise when any other or additional "Coin Operated Amusement Device" as defined in said Sub-section "A", is thereafter acquired or operated by or in such "Club", such information shall be furnished within twenty-four hours after any such additional device as is not theretofore listed with the City Clerk, has been acquired.

Section 2. The City Clerk of the City of Payette is hereby authorized to issue a license to any such "Club" for the operation of such "Coin Operated Amusement Devices" upon the application therefor by such "Club" or someone on its behalf, on a form to be prescribed by the City Clerk, and upon the payment of the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per year for each such "Coin Operated Amusement Device" operated by or in such "Club". Licenses must be renewed from year to year on payment of a like sum for each of such "Coin Operated Amusement Device" of \$50 per device.

Section 3. All licenses shall become due on the first day of July of each year, or on commencing of business of such "Club", or on the installation of any such "Amusement Device". When issued on the first day of July, the tax shall be computed for one year, but when issued at any other date, ~~it shall be computed~~

~~for one year, but when issued at any other date,~~ it shall be computed proportionally on the first day of the month during which said license was applied for, to and including the 30th day of June, following. It shall be unlawful for any such "Club", or any person in charge of or operating such "Club" or any employee or any other person therein, to operate or permit to be operated or to be installed or kept in any such "Club" without first procuring and paying the license fee as herein provided. Any subsequent "Amusement Devices" installed or operated in any such licensed "Club", the initial maintenance or license fee for any such additional device is installed in any such "Club", as such word is defined in said Chapter 112. The owner, manager, operator or any employee thereof, who shall install, operate or permit to be installed or operated in any such "Club", any such "Coin Operated Amusement Device" as defined by said Sub-section "A", which is unlicensed by the City of Payette, Idaho, shall be and is hereby declared to be unlawful, and each such "Club" or person as the case may be, shall be fined for each offense, not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) nor more than one Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) and each day that any such amusement device is kept in any such "Club" without a license being procured therefor, shall be deemed a separate offense and punished as herein provided.
