

ORDINANCE NO. 490

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE 446 ADOPTING "PLUMBING CODE OF THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF MASTER PLUMBERS OF THE UNITED STATES INCORPORATED" AS THE OFFICIAL PLUMBING CODE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE; AMENDING SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE 446 SPECIFYING PIPE TO LAID FOR SEWERS; AMENDING SECTION 4 OF ORDINANCE 446 TO DELETE THE FEE FOR PLUMBING PERMITS; AMENDING SECTION 307 GENERAL ORDINANCES CITY OF PAYETTE, 1920, BEING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE 316, FIXING THE PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE PLUMBING CODE; REPEALING SECTIONS 286, 287, 288, 289, 290, 296, 297, 303, 331, 332, 333 AND 334 OF THE GENERAL ORDINANCES CITY OF PAYETTE, 1920 BEING SECTIONS 2, 4, 6 AND 12 OF ORDINANCE 166 AND SECTIONS 2, 3, 9 AND 13 OF ORDINANCE 235 AND REPEALING ORDINANCES 324 AND 441 ALL OF SUCH SECTIONS AND ORDINANCES REPEALED RELATING TO PLUMBING REGULATIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

Section 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance 446 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. From and after the taking effect of this ordinance all plumbing installations made in the City of Payette, Idaho shall comply and conform with the " Plumbing Code of the National Association of Master Plumbers of the United States Incorporated" . Such " Plumbing Code of the National Association of Master Plumbers of the United States Incorporated" is hereby adopted as the plumbing code of the City of Payette under and by virtue of authority granted by the provisions of Section 49-1802, Idaho Code Annotated, as amended by Section 1 of Chapter 67 of the 1941 Session Laws. Three copies of the above adopted code being on file in the office of the City Clerk and properly certified as being the officially adopted and certified plumbing code of the City of Payette.

Section 2. That Section 3 of Ordinance 446 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 3. From and after the taking effect of this ordinance all connecting lines running to sewers shall be laid with soil pipe, cement, vitrified tile or other approved material.

Section 3. That Section 4 of Ordinance 446 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:
