

ORDINANCE NO. 491

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 110 OF THE GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, 1920, BEING SECTION 5 OF ORDINANCE 110 RELATING TO INTOXICATED PERSONS AND ADDING TWO NEW SECTIONS TO ORDINANCE 110 RELATING TO INTOXICATED DISORDERLY PERSONS AND PERSONS MAKING INDECENT OR IMMORAL EXPOSURES AND FIXING PENALTIES THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

Section 1. That Section 110 of the General Ordinances of the City of Payette, 1920, being Section 5 of Ordinance 110 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 110. Intoxicated Persons. Any person or persons who shall be in a state of intoxication, within the limits of the City of Payette, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not ~~less than Ten Dollars and~~ ~~more than One Hundred Dollars~~ more than One Hundred Dollars and costs of prosecution.

Section 2. That a new section be added to Ordinance 110 to be designated as Section 5A and to read as follows:

Section 5A. Disorderly Intoxicated Persons. Any person or persons, who shall be in a state of intoxication and violent, or riotous, or disorderly or using obscene or indecent language, in or upon any street or alley or in or about any public premises, or place of general or public resort, within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of ~~not less than Ten Dollars and~~ not more than One Hundred Dollars and costs of prosecution.

Section 3. That a new section be added to Ordinance 110 to be designated as Section 5B and to read as follows:


Section 5B. Any person or persons, who shall indecently or immorally expose their person, or who shall commit any indecent or immoral act, in or upon any street, or alley, or in or about any public premises or public place or general public resort, within the corporate limits of the

Section 4. From and after the taking effect of this ordinance no plumbing within the City of Payette, Idaho shall be installed, replaced, altered or changed until a sketch of the proposed work shall be submitted to the Building Inspector who shall issue a permit for the proposed plumbing, provided, the plan thereof conforms with the plumbing code and other restrictions herein. No fee will be charged for the issuing of such permit.

Section 4. That Sections 286, 287, 288, 289, 290, 296, 297, 303, 331, 332, 333 and 334 of the General Ordinances City of Payette, 1920, being Sections 2, 4, 6 and 12 of Ordinance 166 and Sections 2, 3, 9 and 13 of Ordinance 235 and Ordinances 324 and 441 be and the same are hereby repealed.
