

ORDINANCE NO. 492

AN ORDINANCE EXCLUDING FROM THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE A CERTAIN TRACT OF LAND THAT HAS HERETOFORE BEEN CONSIDERED EXCLUDED BUT THROUGH ERRORS IN THE DRAFT OF ORDINANCES DOES NOT SHOW CLEARLY ON THE RECORD AS TO JUST WHAT ~~THE~~ PARCEL OF LAND WAS LEGALLY EXCLUDED FROM THE CITY LIMITS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

Section 1. Whereas, the tract of land hereinafter described has been considered as being excluded from the corporate limits of the City of Payette for many years and the City Council of said City, by Ordinances Nos. 225 and 283 did attempt to exclude a certain portion of said tract from the corporate limits and said City Council did, by Ordinance 280, vacate the balance of said tract of land as a street and the record discloses that there was an error in the description of the tracts attempted to be excluded by said Ordinances 225 and 283 and that the vacation of the street brought about by Ordinance 280 did not legally exclude the same from the corporate limits and it being the intention of the Council of the City of Payette, Idaho to clear the record as to such tract being excluded, therefor,

A tract or parcel of land beginning at the Northeast corner of the intersection of Center Avenue and Sixteenth Street, thence North 400 feet; thence West 750 feet; thence South 400 feet; thence East 750 feet to the point of beginning,

be and the same is hereby excluded from the corporate limits of the City of Payette. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this ordinance with the County Recorder of Payette County, State of Idaho, as required by law.
