ORDINANCE NO. 546

AN ORDINANCE MAKING AN ANNUAL APPROPRIATION AND LEVY FOR GENERAL, ROAD, SALARY, FIRE, STREET-LIGHTING, LIBRARY PURPOSES, AND THE PAYMENT ON THE OUTSTANDING BONDED INDEBTEDNESS OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

SECTION 1. That the sum of \$30,750.30, together with fines, forfeitures and other money not otherwise appropriated, is hereby appropriated for the general expenses of the City of Payette, Idaho, for the Fiscal year commencing on the First day of May, 1949.

SECTION 2. That the sum of \$7,500.00 is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year commencing with the First day of May, 1949, for the purpose of lighting the Streets and Avenues and thoroughfares of the City of Payette, Idaho, and the same shall constitute the Street Lighting Fund.

SECTION 3. That there is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year commencing with the First day of May, 1949, the sum of \$2700.00 for the purpose of maintaining a Public Library, and the same shall constitute the Library Fund.

SECTION 4. That the sum of \$3162.50 is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year commencing with the First day of May 1949, for the purpose of paying interest on all outstanding general obligation bonds of the City of Payette, Idaho, and the same shall constitute the Bond Interest Fund.

SECTION 5. That the sum of \$6,000.00 is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year commencing with the First day of May, 1949, for the redemption of the outstanding General Obligation Bonds of the City of Payette, Idaho, and the same shall constitute the Bond Sinking Fund.

SECTION 6. That the sum of \$2500.00 is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year commencing with the First day of May, 1949, for the purpose of buying Fire Fighting Equipment, and the same shall constitute the Fire Equipment Fund.

SECTION 7. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year, commencing with the First day of May, 1949, the sum of twenty (20) mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation, of all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho, and the funds realized from such levy, together with all fines, licenses, forfeitures, and moneys not otherwise appropriated, shall be for and constitute the General Fund of the City of Payette, Idaho.

SECTION 8. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing with the first day of May, 1949, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho, the sum of six (6) mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of said property and the funds realized from such levy shall be and the same shall constitute the Street Lighting Fund.

SECTION 9. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing with the first day of May, 1949, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho, the sum of two (2) mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of said property and the funds realized from such levy shall constitute the Library Fund of the City of Payette, Idaho.

SECTION 10. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing with the first day of May, 1949, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho, the sum of two (2) mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of said property and the funds realized from such levy shall constitute the Bond Interest Fund of the City of Payette, Idaho.

SECTION 11. That there is hereby levied, for the fiscal year, commencing with the first day of May, 1949, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho, the sum of four (4) mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of said property, and the funds realized from such levy shall be and constitute the Bond Sinking Fund of said City.

SECTION 12. That there is hereby levied, for the fiscal year, commencing with the first day of May, 1949, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho, the sum of two (2) mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of said property, and the funds realized from such levy, shall be and constitute the Fire Equipment Fund of said City.
