

ORDINANCE NO. 568

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO THE OREGON SHORT LINE RAILROAD COMPANY, (UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY LESSEE), ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS, A FRANCHISE AND RIGHT TO OPERATE, MAINTAIN AND USE A SAND HOUSE, IN SIXTH STREET BETWEEN CENTER AVENUE AND FIRST AVENUE SOUTH IN THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

BE IT ORDAINED By the Mayor and City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

SECTION 1. That a Franchise be, and the same is hereby granted to the Oregon Short Line Railroad Company (Union Pacific Railroad Company, Lessee), its successors and assigns, the right to operate, maintain and use a sandhouse, being thirteen and five (13.5) feet wide and twenty-two and three tenths (22.3) feet long in Sixth Street, between Center Avenue and First Avenue South in the City of Payette, Idaho, and eight and five tenths (8.5) feet distant westerly from and parallel to the present spur track operated along the center of said Sixth Street, the location of said Sand House being more particularly shown in yellow upon the attached print, which is hereby made a part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force for a period of five years from and after its passage, approval and publication.


