

ORDINANCE No. 574

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 2-114 REVISED CODE OF PAYETTE 1946 WHICH PROHIBITED ANY MUSIC OTHER THAN A COIN OPERATED PHONOGRAPH WITHIN THE PLACE OF BUSINESS OF A RETAIL DEALER IN BEER, AND REPEALING SECTION 2-115 REVISED CODE OF PAYETTE 1946 WHICH PROHIBITED DANCING IN THE PLACE OF BUSINESS OF A RETAIL DEALER IN BEER.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

Section 1. That Section 2-114 Revised Code of Payette, 1946, which prohibited any music other than a coin operated phonograph within the place of business of a retail dealer in beer, be, and the same hereby is, repealed.

Section 2. That Section 2-115 Revised Code of Payette, 1946, which prohibited dancing in the place of business of a retail dealer in beer, be, and the same hereby is, repealed.
