

ORDINANCE NO. 588

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 582 BY CHANGING THE DESIGNATION OF SECTION 5(d) TO SECTION 5(f); BY ADDING A NEW SECTION DESIGNATED 5(d) TO PROVIDE FOR DAILY USE FEES AND REGULATIONS OF PARKING SPACE WITHIN PARKING METER ZONES; BY ADDING A NEW SECTION DESIGNATED AS 5(e) TO PROVIDE FOR MONTHLY USE FEES AND REGULATIONS OF PARKING SPACE WITHIN PARKING METER ZONES; BY AMENDING SECTION 9 RELATIVE TO THE MANNER OF PAYMENT AND AMOUNT OF PENALTY FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH SAID ORDINANCE; AND BY AMENDING SECTION 8(b) TO PROVIDE FOR THE DISPOSITION OF FINES AND PENALTIES LEVIED, ASSESSED AND COLLECTED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF SAID ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

Section 1. That Section 5(d) of Ordinance No. 582 of the City of Payette, Idaho, be hereafter designated as 5(f).

Section 2. That a new section designated as 5(d) of Ordinance No. 582 be added as follows:

"Professional people or workmen who are in the need of their vehicles in the immediate vicinity of their work for tools, equipment, etc. may obtain from the City Clerk's office a canvas parking meter bag with an attached padlock to cover a parking meter head, together with a tag to be attached thereto by the workman when his work at that location has been completed. This bag is to be placed over the parking meter head and padlocked. The parking meter covered to be for the parking space that the workman's vehicle would occupy. No company or individual may occupy more than two consecutive parking spaces at the same time.

The above mentioned parking meter bag shall be rented to the professional person or workman at a charge of thirty cents (30¢) per day. The bag shall be rented from the City Clerk's office each day of its use. It shall be padlocked on the meter by the user and collected from such meter by some member of the Police Department every night after the hour of 6:00 o'clock P.M., or at any time when there shall be attached thereto a tag indicating that the work at that location has been completed. The condition of the bag and padlock shall be noted and a report made of such condition. If any damage is noted it shall be charged to the person or persons renting such piece of equipment."

Section 3. That a new section designated as 5(e) of Ordinance No. 582 be added as follows:

"Professional people and workmen using their vehicles in their profession for collecting or unloading of merchandise, who in their profession move their vehicle from parking space to parking space, may file an application with the City Clerk for a parking meter permit. Said application shall be acted on by the Police Committee of the City Council and may be approved or disapproved by said committee at their discretion, and such permit if issued shall be subject to revocation by said committee upon showing to the satisfaction of the committee of abuse or misuse of said permit. Said permit shall entitle the vehicle for which issued to the use of one parking space for a period not to exceed that fixed by resolution of the City Council, which said resolution may be from time to time amended and a copy thereof attached hereto and made a part hereof. This permit shall be placed in the lower left corner of the vehicle's windshield so that it is visible at all times while the vehicle occupies any parking meter space in the City of Payette, Idaho. This parking meter permit shall be issued upon payment of a fee at the rate of Three Dollars (\$3.00) per month. It shall be plainly marked by the City Clerk so that the period for which it is issued and the State license number of the vehicle issued to is plainly visible. Not more than two consecutive parking spaces shall be occupied by any person or company whose vehicles bear such parking meter permits. The fee for an unexpired term of any permit so issued cannot be refunded for any cause."

Section 4. That Section 9 of Ordinance 582 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 9. Enforcement. It shall be the duty of the police officers of the City of Payette, acting in accordance with instructions issued by the Chief of Police, to report: (a) The number of each parking meter which indicates that the vehicle occupying the parking space adjacent to such parking meter; or has been parking in violation of any of the provisions of this Ordinance; (b) The State license number of such vehicle; (c) The time during which a vehicle is parking in violation of any of the provisions of this Ordinance; (d) Any other facts, a knowledge of which is necessary to a thorough understanding of the circumstances attending such violation.


Each such police officer shall also attach to such vehicle a notice to the owner or operator thereof that such vehicle has been parked in violation of a provision of this Ordinance and instructing such owner or operator to report at the City Clerk's office in the City of Payette, Idaho, with regard to such violation. Within the first hour (sixty minutes) from the time written on the violation ticket, the violator may deposit in the meter at the City Clerk's office, placed there for this purpose, the sum of five cents (5¢), or one nickel, as a penalty for and in full satisfaction of such violation. Within the time of two hours (one hundred twenty minutes) from the time written on the violation ticket the violator may in person present to the City Clerk's office or police officer the sum of Fifty Cents (50¢) and receive a receipt for the same as a penalty for and in full satisfaction of such violation.

If such violation occurred after the hour of 4:00 o'clock P.M. on any day, Monday through Friday, or after the hour of 11:00 o'clock A.M. on Saturday of any week, the violator shall have until 11:00 o'clock A.M. of the following day to deposit in the meter at the City Clerk's office the sum of five cents (5¢) as above set forth, or until 12:00 o'clock noon the following day to pay the sum of fifty cents (50¢) as above set forth. Any owner or operator who fails to make payment in either of the above prescribed manners, may within the period of twenty-four hours following such violation pay at the City Clerk's office the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) as a penalty for and in full satisfaction of such violation. If the day following the violation be a Sunday or legal holiday, the violator may on the first business day following the violation comply with the above regulations. The failure of such owner or operator to make such payment within said twenty-four hour period shall render such owner or operator subject to the penalties hereinafter provided for violation of the provisions of this Ordinance.


Section 5. That Section 8(b) of Ordinance No. 582 be, and the same is hereby, amended to read as follows:

"All fines, forfeitures and penalties levied, assessed and collected under the provisions of this Ordinance shall be delivered to the City Clerk and the City Clerk shall make a record of the same and deposit the same to the credit of the City of Payette, Idaho, in a special fund to be known as the "Parking Meter Special and Trust Fund." The coins deposited in parking meters shall be collected by the duly authorized agent of the city and shall be delivered by him to the City Clerk. The Clerk of the City shall count the coins so delivered and make a record of the same and deposit the same to the credit of the City of Payette, Idaho, in such bank or banks as the City Council may designate as the depository for City Funds, in a special fund to be known as the "Parking Meter Special and Trust Fund."
