AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING/CERTAIN TRACT OF LAND HEREIN DESCRIBED TO THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, AND DECLARING THE SAME TO BE ANNEXED, BY PROPER LEGAL DESCRIPTION TO BE A PART OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

WHEREAS, The following described parcel of real property, which is contiguous to the City of Payette, Idaho, has heretofore been laid off into lots containing less than five (5) acres of land each by the owners thereof, to-wit:

Beginning at a point 356.8 feet North of the Southwest corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 34, Township 9 North, Range 5 West of the Boise Meridian; run thence North along the West side line of said SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  a distance of 340.16 feet; run thence West 142 feet; thence run North 609.74 feet to the North side line of the S $\frac{1}{2}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 34; thence run East along said North side line 806.5 feet to a point 664.5 feet East of the Northwest corner of said SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ; run thence South 30 feet; run thence East and parallel to the North side line 150 feet; thence South and parallel to the East side line of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$  447.5 feet; run thence West and parallel to said North side line 150 feet; run thence South and parallel to said East side line to a point 663.5 feet to the point of beginning.

East of the point of beginning; thence West 663.5 feet

NOW, THEREFORE, The hereinabove described tract is hereby annexed to the City of Payette, Idaho, and is hereby declared by proper legal description to be a part of the City of Payette.
