

AN ORDINANCE VACATING CERTAIN LANDS WITHIN THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, AND PROVIDING THAT THE VACATED LANDS SHALL REVERT TO THE OWNERS OF THE ABUTTING REAL ESTATE AND BECOME A PART OF SUCH ABUTTING LOTS, AND RESERVING EXISTING EASEMENTS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

Section 1. That the following described premises are hereby vacated to the abutting owners, being not necessary to the regular streets and alleys of the City of Payette; that the same shall revert to the abutting owners of the City of Payette:

Description of property to be vacated:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of Lot 6 in Block 2 of the Chapman Addition to Payette as shown in Page 12, Book 1, of Plats, in the Payette County Recorders' Office; thence South 285 feet along the east side of the alley running through said Block 2; thence West 10 feet to the West side of said alley; thence North 285 feet to a point 10 feet west of the point of beginning; thence East 10 feet to the point of beginning.

Beginning at the Northeast corner of Block 85 of Riverside Addition as shown on page 10, Book 1 of Plats in the Payette County Recorders' Office; thence west along the North side line of said Block 85, 300 feet to the Northwest corner thereof; thence north 9 feet along the east side of North 5th Street to the North sideline of the alley between Block 85 and Block 82 of said Riverside Addition; thence East 300 feet along said North sideline to the Southeast corner of Block 82 of said Riverside Addition; thence south 9 feet to the point of beginning.

Also, beginning at the Northeast Corner of Lot 6, Block 2 of the Chapman Addition as shown on Page 12, Book 1 of Plats in the Payette County Recorders' Office; thence West along the North side line of said Block 2, 300 feet to the East side line of North 4th Street; thence North 9 feet to the Southwest corner of Lot 7, Block 2 of the Maxfield Addition to Payette as shown on Page 4, Book 1 of Plats in the Payette County Recorders' Office; thence East 300 feet along the South sideline of said Block 2 of the Maxfield Addition; thence South 9 feet to the point of beginning.

Section 2. That all easements now in existence under, in and upon the lands forming the above described property shall remain and be in full force and effect.
