

ORDINANCE NO. 678

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 17 OF TITLE 10 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE RELATING TO THE REGISTRATION OF BICYCLES WITHIN THE CITY OF PAYETTE BY AMENDING SECTIONS 10-17-2, 10-17-3 AND 10-17-4.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

Section 1. That Section 10-17-2 of the Municipal Code of the City of Payette be, and the same is hereby, amended to read as follows:

"10-17-2: TIME OF REGISTRATION: Every bicycle in the City must be registered with the Clerk, showing the proper name and address of the owner, and the make, serial number and general description of the bicycle, and the name of the person or dealer from whom such bicycle was purchased."

Section 2. That Section 10-17-3 of the Municipal Code of the City of Payette be, and the same is hereby, amended to read as follows:

"10-17-3: NUMBER PLATE: At the time of registration, a number plate shall be assigned to said bicycle which number plate must be attached to the rear of said bicycle in plain view. Said number plate shall remain on said bicycle and in event of loss said bicycle shall be reregistered with the Clerk in the same manner as the original registration including payment of registration fee."

Section 3. That Section 10-17-4 of the Municipal Code of the City of Payette be, and the same is hereby, amended to read as follows:

"10-17-4: REGISTRATION FEE: Every bicycle owner shall pay a fee of fifty cents (50¢) for each bicycle registered and to which a number plate is issued. In case of a sale or transfer of a bicycle from one individual to another, the registration shall be cancelled and the bicycle shall be re-registered in the name of the purchaser in the same manner as an original registration including the payment of registration fee. The Clerk shall be responsible under his official bond for all moneys collected under and pursuant to this Chapter and shall account to and deliver all such moneys in
