

ORDINANCE NO. 701

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER NO. 6-1-5 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, RELATING TO GAMBLING TO PROVIDE FOR THE REMOVING OF PARAGRAPHS PROVIDING THAT CITY OFFICERS SHALL HAVE THE DUTY TO ISSUE WARRANTS OR INFORM AGAINST PERSONS VIOLATING SAID STATUTE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

That Section 6-1-5 of the Municipal Code of the City of Payette be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:


GAMBLING: Every person who deals, plays or carries on, opens or causes to be opened, or who conducts either as owner, or lessee, whether for hire or not any game of faro, monte, roulette, lasquet, rouge-et-noir, or ronder, or any game played with cards, dice or any other devise, for money, checks credit or any other representative of value, within the City Limits is guilty of a misdemeanor.

Every person who knowingly permits any of the games prohibited by the preceding Section, to be played, conducted, or dealt in any house owned, rented or conducted by such person, in whole or in part, is punishable as provided for in this Code.

Every person duly summoned as a witness for the prosecution on any proceeding had under this Section who neglects or refuses to attend, as required, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.
