

AN ORDINANCE

AMENDING SUBSECTION (A), SECTION 9, CHAPTER 7, TITLE 10 OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE BY ADDING PARAGRAPH 15 WHICH PROHIBITS THE PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES AT CERTAIN HOURS ON CITY STREETS ADJOINING REAL PROPERTY OF ANOTHER UNLESS CONSENT OF THE OWNER, TENANT OR LESSEE IS OBTAINED: AND BY ADDING PARAGRAPH 16 WHICH PROHIBITS THE PARKING OF CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLES AT ANY TIME ON CITY STREETS ADJOINING REAL PROPERTY OF ANOTHER UNLESS CONSENT OF OWNER, TENANT OR LESSEE IS OBTAINED.

Be It Ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, State of Idaho:

That Subsection (A), Section 9, Chapter 7, Title 10 of the City Code of the City of Payette, State of Idaho, be amended by adding new paragraphs thereto, following Section 10-7-9(A)14, to be known as Sections 10-7-9(A)15 and 10-7-9(A)16.

10-7-9(A) No person shall stop, stand, or park a vehicle, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with law or the directions of a police officer or traffic control device, in any of the following places:

1. On a sidewalk;
2. In front of a public or private driveway;
3. Within an intersection;
4. Within fifteen feet (15') of a fire hydrant;
5. On a crosswalk;
6. Within twenty feet (20') of a crosswalk at an intersection;
7. Within thirty feet (30') upon the approach to any flashing beacon, stop sign, or traffic control signal located at the side of a roadway;
8. Between a safety zone and the adjacent curb or within thirty feet (30') of points on the curb immediately opposite the ends of a safety zone, unless the traffic authority indicates a different length by signs or markings;
9. Within fifty feet (50') of the nearest rail of a railroad crossing;
10. Within twenty feet (20') of a driveway entrance to any fire station, on the side of a street opposite the entrance to any fire station within seventy five feet (75') of said entrance when properly signposted;
11. Alongside or opposite any street excavation or obstruction when stopping, standing, or parking would obstruct traffic;
12. On the roadway side of any vehicle stopped or parked at the edge or curb of a street;
13. Upon any bridge or other elevated structure upon a highway or within a highway tunnel;
14. At any place where official signs prohibit stopping;
15. *Off the main-traveled part of a street or highway adjoining real property owned by another person between the hours of 1:00 o'clock A.M. and 6:00 o'clock A.M., unless consent is given by the person owning, renting, or leasing said real property.*
16. *Off the main-traveled part of a street or highway adjoining real property owned by another person at any time if the motor vehicle being stopped or parked is other than an automobile, pickup truck, or a passenger vehicle, unless consent is given by the person owning, renting or leasing said real property.*
