

ORDINANCE NO. 796

AN ORDINANCE

AMENDING SECTIONS 3-3-18 AND 3-3-20 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, TO PROVIDE FOR THE INCREASE IN RATES CHARGED FOR USE OF WATER PROVIDED BY THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, AND TO PROVIDE FOR A STANDARD CHARGE FOR INSTALLING TAP PIPES AND CONNECTING SAME WITH CURB BOXES.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section 3-3-18: WATER RATES: The monthly charges for City Water shall be made and collected at the following rates:

(A) The minimum monthly charge for each meter service within the City Limits shall be ~~two-dollars-fifty-cents-(\$2.50)~~ four dollars (\$4.00), and outside the City Limits shall be ~~three-dollars-(\$3.00)~~ four dollars eighty cents (\$4.80). This minimum charge shall entitle the user to the delivery of four thousand (4000) gallons of water during each such month.

(B) For all amounts of water used in any month in excess of four thousand (4000) gallons and not to exceed forty thousand (40,000) gallons, the charge shall be ~~twenty-five-cents-(25¢)~~ forty cents (40¢) for each one thousand (1000) gallons or fraction thereof.

(C) For all amounts of water used in any month in excess of forty thousand (40,000) gallons and not to exceed one hundred thousand (100,000) gallons, the charge shall be ~~eight-cents-(8¢)~~ thirteen (13¢) for each one thousand (1000) gallons, or fraction thereof.

(D) For all amounts of water used in any month in excess of one hundred thousand (100,000) gallons, the charge shall be ~~seven-cents-(7¢)~~ eleven cents (11¢) for each one thousand (1000) gallons or fraction thereof.

Section 3-3-20: ~~ESTIMATE-OF-COSTS:~~ COSTS TO PROVIDE TAP PIPE AND SERVICE:

~~An-actual-cost-charge~~ The sum of One Hundred and no/100 (\$100.00) Dollars shall be paid for putting in each tap pipe to connect the same with the curb box and for furnishing the box and other material service; an additional One and No/100 (\$1.00) Dollar shall be paid for the installation of each foot of tap pipe in excess of twenty five (25) feet; a further charge for the actual cost of repairing the street after the installation of the tap pipe shall also be paid, such actual cost charge to be estimated by the waterworks committee.

That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Independent Enterprise, a newspaper of general circulation in the City and County of Payette, Idaho.
