

ORDINANCE NO. 86A

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2 TITLE 2 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, TO PROVIDE FOR PENALTIES FOR DAMAGING OR RETAINING LIBRARY PROPERTY.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho that Chapter 2 of Title 2 of the Municipal Code of the City of Payette, Idaho, be amended by the addition of the following sections:

2-2-6: DEFACING LIBRARY PROPERTY: No person shall wilfully or intentionally cut, tear, deface, break, injure or destroy any book, map, chart, picture, engraving, newspaper, magazine, pamphlet, manuscript or other property belonging to the Payette Public Library or any branch thereof.


2-2-7: UNLAWFUL RETAINING OF LIBRARY PROPERTY: No person shall retain any book, newspaper, magazine, pamphlet, manuscript or other property belonging to the Payette Public Library, or any branch thereof, for more than three (3) days after notice in writing to return the same. Giving of notice shall be deemed sufficient if given in person or if mailed to the address of such person as shown by the library records. Service by mail is complete at time of mailing.

2-2-8: PENALTY: Any person violating any of the provisions of this Chapter shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be subject to incarceration six (6) months in jail and/or a \$300.00 fine.


