

ORDINANCE NO. 923

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 6.08.020 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, TO PROVIDE FOR ADDITIONAL FEES FOR LATE APPLICATIONS FOR DOG LICENSES.

Be it Ordained by the Mayor and Council that Section 6.08.020 of the Municipal Code of the City of Payette be amended as follows:

6.08.020 License--Fees--Payment penalties--Nontransferability--Lost Tag.

A. Fees. The clerk is authorized to issue a license and tag to any person applying therefor upon the payment of five dollars for each dog, commencing February 29, 1980. All licenses, except for the year 1980, must be dated from the first of the calendar year in which they were granted; the actual issuance date is also to be noted on the license.

B. Due Date. The tag shall have stamped thereon the year for which such tag is issued, and a number that will correspond with the number on the license. Such license fees shall be due and payable on January 1st of each and every year, except for the year of 1980 when such license fees shall be due on or before February 29th, and except as hereinafter provided.

C. Exceptions. Any dog born subsequent to the due date for the license fee shall be licensed by the payment of the appropriate license fee, within three months after its birth, and any dog brought into the city subsequent to the license fee due date shall be licensed by the payment of the appropriate license fee immediately after being brought into the city.

D. Term. All licenses and tags issued under this chapter shall be nontransferable, and shall expire on December 31st of each year.

E. Lost Tag. A duplicate or replacement tag shall be issued by the clerk upon payment of one dollar for each tag so issued to replace the original tag which was lost or destroyed.


F. Additional Fees for Late Application. Any person applying for a license later than forty-five (45) days after the date the fees for the license have become due shall pay an additional fee of \$5.00, except in the year 1981, when said additional fees shall not be collected unless application for a license is after May 1, 1981. After the late application fee has become due and collectible, a subsequent additional one (\$1.00) dollar fee shall be charged for each and every thirty (30) day period thereafter for the late application for a license.

That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Independent Enterprise, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Payette, Idaho.
