

ORDINANCE NO. 992

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE AMENDING ORDINANCE 984; BY REPEALING SECTIONS 5.29.030 (b), 5.30.50, 5.29.050 (c) and AMENDING SECTIONS 5.29.030 (a), 5.29.030 (b), 5.30.070; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING A REPEALER; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section 1: Section 5.29.030 (a) is hereby amended as follows:

Fee levied; amount; effect upon other license fee provisions.

(a) There is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from every person engaged in any business or occupation within the city a license fee for the privilege of engaging in business in an amount to be determined by the application of the rates hereinafter set forth. Such license fee shall be a one time fee of \$10.00 for the application. ~~and \$10.00 per year thereafter.~~

(b) Section 5.29.030 (b) is hereby repealed.

Section 2: Section 5.29.050 (c) is hereby repealed.

Section 3: Section 5.29.060 of Ordinance 984 is hereby amended as follows:

Engaging in business without obtaining license prohibited; expiration of license. No person shall engage in any business or activity in the city for which a license fee is imposed by this article, without first having obtained and being a holder of a valid and subsisting license to do so, to be known as a business and occupation license, issued under the provisions of this article, and without paying the license fee imposed by this article, which license fee shall accompany the application for the license. ~~Such license shall expire at the end of the calendar year in which it is issued.~~

Section 4: Section 5.30.070. Is hereby amended as follows:


All funds received by the city under the terms of this article shall be paid into the general fund of the city. ~~and budgeted annually for general municipal purposes in the departments of police, fire, building, and health.~~

Section 5: Section 5.30.50 is hereby repealed.

Section 6: Severability. If any portion of this Ordinance is found to be unenforceable or unconstitutional for any reason, the remaining portion of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 7: Repealer. Any portions of any existing Ordinances which are in direct conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the conflict exists.

Section 8: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on the day of immediately upon passage and publication as required by law.
