

ORDINANCE NO. 10.

An ordinance fixing the compensation of the officers of the City of Payette.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette:

Section I. The city attorney shall receive for his services the sum of one hundred dollars per annum, and ten dollars for each prosecution before a police magistrate or justice of the peace in which he shall appear as attorney for the city.

Section II. The city clerk, as such clerk, ex officio collector and auditor, shall be entitled to the sum of five (5) dollars per month, and, an amount in addition thereto equal to the amount of fees received and turned over by him to the city treasurer for copies of instruments or records of his office furnished by him to parties other than city officials, and to the sum of fifty cents for each license issued by him, which fees shall be first turned over by him to the city treasurer.

Section III. The city treasurer shall receive for his services the sum of twenty five dollars per annum.

Section IV. The city marshal shall receive for his services the sum of fifty dollars per month.

Section V. The police judge shall receive the same fees as justices of the peace for similar services.

Section VI. The city engineer shall receive for his services the sum of one hundred dollars per annum, and five dollars per day for all work outside of his regular employment, such as preparing plans and specifications for public buildings, water works, drainage systems, etc.

Section VII. The road overseer shall receive for his services the sum of three dollars per day for each and every day actually engaged in the work of his office.

Section VIII. All ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
