

ORDINANCE NO. 13.

An ordinance to provide a labor tax for road purposes upon the male residents of the City of Payette.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette.

Section I. That all able bodied male residents of the City of Payette excepting members of fire companies, in good standing , between the ages of twenty-one and fifty years, between the first day of April and the first day of September of each year, either by themselves or satisfactory substitute, shall perform two day's labor upon the streets, alleys or highways within the City of Payette, at such times as the road overseer may direct, and upon three day's notice , in writing, given to them by said road overseer.

Section II. That for each day's failure to attend and perform the labor as required from the male residents, at the time and place specified in said written notice, the delinquent shall forfeit and pay to the City of Payette the sum of one dollar for each day's delinquency, and the amount so due shall be treated and collected as taxes for that year, and it shall be the duty of the city council to certify the amount due from each individual so delinquent as aforesaid to the county tax collector, and the certificate of the city clerk under seal of the city, that the person named therein has performed the labor and paid the forfeiture herein required, shall be received by the tax collector in discharge of the amount due from such person.

Section III. That the amount of said forfeiture may, in all cases, and in addition to the mode hereinbefore provided, be recovered by action before any competent tribunal, in the name of the State of Idaho, and the amount so collected shall be certified by the city council to the county tax collector in discharge of the amount due from such delinquent person.

Section IV. That the road overseer shall make a full report of all said delinquencies to the city council, accompanied with a copy of the notice served upon each delinquent person, with a statement thereon showing the time and the manner of the notice.

Section V. All ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed .
