O-R-D-I-N-A-N-C-E N-O. 140 *W. B. G. G. G.*

An Ordinance, granting a franchise to the (Idaho-Oregon Light and Power Company,) a corporation, its successors and assigns the right and privilege to erect poles, stretch wires, other needful appliances and to maintain the same along and across the Streets and alleys of the village of Payette, and the right to construct and operate works for the manufacture of gas and the laying down of pipes and conduits and erection of street and other lamps and lamp posts and appliances for the introducing into and supplying said village and its inhabitants with gas either natural or artificial, for heating, cooking, illuminating, power and other purposes, along and across said streets and alleys, and the right to construct maintain and operate over and across and along the streets and alleys of said village a street railway system.

Be it Ordained by the Village of Payette, Idaho by the chairman and Board of Trustees of said village, as follows:-

Section 1, There is hereby granted, to the Idaho-Oregon Light and Power Company, its successors and assigns under the terms and conditions hereinafter contained, the right and permission to erect poles, stretch wires, and other appliances and to maintain and operate the same for electric power, light and heating purposes, along and across the streets and alleys within the corporate limits of said village of Payette, as the same now exists or may hereafter be extended, for the purpose of supplying the said village and inhabitants thereof with said electrical light, heat and power and transmitting the same over the line of said corporation. And the right to construct and operate works, for the manufacture of gas within the said Village of Payette also the right of way along, upon and under all the avenues, streets, alleys, and public ^{subways} in said village for the purpose of placing, operating, repairing and maintaining a line or line of gas mains and pipes and all necessary meters and ser-

vice pipes and connections therewith for the distribution of gas for heating, cooking, illuminating and power purposes, either artificial or natural, and the right to construct, maintain and operate a single or double tract railway line upon the streets and alleys of said village for the purpose of carrying passengers, baggage, express, U. S. Mail; and freight and other useful, ordinary and necessary purposes, with all turn-out, switches, side tracks and other appurtenances which may be necessary or expedient.

Section 2, The poles and lines hereby authorized to be erected shall be placed at the outer edge of the curb or sidewalk whereon the same may be erected, in such place or places as will not interfere with the ordinary use of the same, and shall be erected in the alleys near the side line thereof,

Section 3, All poles erected under this franchise shall be maintained in a sound and substantial condition, and all wires shall be securely attached, proper arms or braces, attached to said poles for that purpose, with the necessary insulators.

Section 4, The said corporation shall do no permanent injury to any streets, sidewalks, alleys, avenues or public place or in any manner unnecessarily disturb or interfere with any water pipe sewer, gas pipe, conduit, or any under ground work, now or hereafter made by said city; and when said corporation shall open ground in any street it shall forthwith restore the said pavement, sidewalk or ground or water pipe or sewer, gas pipe, conduit or other under ground work, to a condition equally as good as before at the expense of said corporation, and if said corporation shall fail or refuse to repair the same such repairs may be made by the said village of Payette and the said corporation shall be liable for the expense.

Section 5, The said corporation shall also have the right to erect poles , stretch wires , and lay conduits along said street and alleys of said Village of Payette as may be necessary or in the operation of their street railway .

All of the construction of the said line of said corporation shall be laid upon grades, established by and under the supervision of the City Engineer of said Village of Payette , PROVIDED that said Village has at the time of the construction of said line an established grade.

Section, 6, In consideration of the franchise herein granted said corporation, its successors and assigns, shall furnish electrical current to said village of Payette and to the inhabitants thereof in not exceeding the following rates:- to-wit:-

For lighting purposes, fifteen cents per kilowat hour; for power purposes ten cents per kilowat hour; PROVIDED , that said corporation shall ~~have~~ and maintain a sliding scale of rates whereby lighting or power in large quantities shall obtain substantial reductions from the above prices, and PROVIDED, further, that the rate charged by said corporation to the said Village of Payette and its inhabitants , shall not be higher than those charged by said corporation, at Weiser , Ontario, Boise, and other cities along its line similarly situated , and under like provisions PROVIDED, further that said Corporation shall permit a reduction or discount of ten percent for payment by any customer at its office during the first ten days of the succeeding month in which any such light of power is used;

The said corporation shall charge the Village of Payette not exceeding the following rates for arc lights and incandescent lighting to-wit:-

Moonly Schedule and dark nights, 450 watt arc lamps, \$60.00 per year; 50 candle power incandescent lamps, \$18.00 per year.

All night and every night schedule, 450 watt arc lamps, \$72.00 per year; 50 candle power incandescent lamps, \$21.00 per year,

Section 7, The said corporation further agrees to furnish ^{electric power} to said Village of Payette for pumping water for the use of said Village and its inhabitants thereof, on the following terms and conditions to-wit:- at a rate of two and one half (2½) cents per kilowatt-hour for current; or at a rate not to exceed four (4) cents per 1000 gallons of water pumped, with a total lift of 130 feet and a pump efficiency of 75 percent.

Section 8, In further consideration of the franchise herein and hereby granted, the said corporation agrees to furnish the said Village of Payette, the following amount of service for which no charge shall be made by said corporation, to-wit:-

One hundred kilowatt hours per month for lighting the City hall of said Village of Payette, which said free service to said Village of Payette shall be deemed to be the ^{license} tax paid by said corporation for this franchise and in no event shall this corporation make any charge or claim against said village for said one hundred kilowatt hours per month for the use of said City Hall.

Section 9, In further consideration of the franchise herein granted the said corporation shall make special rates for the industries about to be established in the said Village of Payette or which may hereafter be established under such terms and conditions as may be just, it being the understanding that said corporation shall assist in the bringing in of new industries and the location thereof of the same in said village of Payette.

Section 10, This right and franchise is granted and shall be in force and effect, for the term of fifty years from and after the passage of this ordinance.

Section 11, Upon the failure of the said corporation, its successors or assigns to commence the erection of poles under this franchise, for the said electric, light, heat and power line
