

ORDINANCE NO. 17.

An ordinance relating to roadways, sidewalks, and the grading of streets in the City of Payette.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette:

Section I. That along all streets 120 feet in width, the roadway shall be 60 feet wide: along all streets 100 feet in width the roadway shall be 50 feet wide: along all streets less than 100 feet in width the street shall be 60 per cent of the entire width of such street, and the center of each roadway shall be the center of each street, and all that portion of any street on either side of the roadway shall be deemed and taken as side-walk.

Section II. That each street shall be graded in the following manner and conform to the established grade. The center of the roadway and the outer edge of the sidewalk, or curb line, shall be on the established grade. The bottom of the gutter on each side of the roadway shall be two feet toward the center of the roadway from the curb line, and shall be fifteen inches below the established grade. The roadway shall be graded on a regular curve across the street. The sidewalk shall be graded with a fall of one inch toward the curb line.

Section III. The following streets shall be graded in accordance with section two of this ordinance, to-wit: Boise street and Front street between Payette avenue and Tioga street: Broad street between Payette avenue and the railroad right of way, and all those portions of Grand avenue, Ada avenue, Main street and Payette avenue, lying between Front and Boise streets, and that portion of Commercial street lying between Broad street and Boise street.

Section IV. All ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
