ORDINANCE NO. 178 BY Saul

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE GRADING OF SIDEWALKS OR SIDEWALK SPACE WITHIN THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO.

Be it ordained by the mayor and Council of the City of Payette:

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Payette, may by an order entered upon its minutes, at any regular, or special meeting ~~called for that purpose~~, order the grading <sup>for</sup> ~~of~~ sidewalks or sidewalk space and direct the Clerk to notify the owner, agent or attorney of all lots or ~~part~~ parts of lots affected by such improvements to make such improvements at their own expense ~~to~~ the extent that their respective pieces of property are chargeable with the cost of such improvements. Such notice shall be given in writing and if the grading <sup>of</sup> such sidewalk or sidewalk space is not begun within ~~the time specified in the~~ <sup>the time specified in the</sup> ~~order~~ <sup>order</sup> and completed within ~~such time as the order requiring the same~~ <sup>the time limit fixed in said</sup> ~~notice~~ <sup>notice</sup> ~~to be made shall require fix~~, then it shall be the duty of the Mayor and Council to let the grading to the lowest responsible bidder who may be required to give a bond for at least 25% of the amount of the bid, ~~for the completion of the same within the~~ <sup>calls for bids</sup> ~~time required for the completion of the same.~~ All ~~contracts~~ shall be advertised in some weekly newspaper published in the City of Payette for two successive weeks, said bids to be opened in the presence of the Mayor and City Council.

Section 2. Immediately after completion of all contract work provided for in this ordinance, it shall be the duty of the City Clerk to make out a bill of account, in the name of the City of Payette against the owner of said property <sup>for</sup> ~~in~~ the grading so made and performed and present to the owner, his agent or attorney for payment. Said account shall include the cost of advertising as well as the improvement so made and shall be sworn to by the City Clerk. If not paid on demand or within two days thereafter it shall be filed with the County Assessor who shall enter it

as a tax charge against the name of the owner of the property upon the assessment roll upon whose property the grading shall have been made and shall be a lien upon said property, ~~into whose-  
soevers hands it shall pass~~. The penalty for non-payment shall be ten per cent (10%) on the account so filed and legal interest shall be paid thereon when collected, and said ~~taxes~~ <sup>sum</sup> shall be collected as other taxes. ~~are collected~~.

Section 3. All bills of account as specified in section 2 of this ordinance ~~shall be paid~~ if not paid on presentation shall be presented, audited and paid, <sup>out of the General Fund</sup> as other accounts against the City of Payette ~~are paid~~.

Section 4. When said taxes are paid they shall, together with penalty, cost of advertising and accrued interest, be paid to the City Treasurer, who shall <sup>credit the amount</sup> ~~keep account of all moneys paid out as provided in this ordinance, from~~ <sup>to</sup> the general fund.

Section 5. All work herein mentioned shall be approved by the Mayor and Council or some person by them ~~appointed~~ appointed for that purpose and shall be under their direction.
