ORDINANCE NO. 183 BY Burns

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING CONNECTIONS WITH SEWERS IN ANY SEWER DISTRICT OF THE CITY, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette;

Section 1. Within thirty days after notice <sup>from</sup> ~~by~~ the City ~~Engineer~~ <sup>Clerk</sup> so to do, the owner or occupant of any premises ~~of any~~ within a sewer district that is occupied all of the time or a portion of the day, shall connect with the City sewer all closets, wash stands, sinks, privies or other places of like nature, or if proper drainage facilities do not exist, said owner or occupant shall provide at least one water closet or privy and one kitchen sink and the City Engineer shall require such other number of closets or sinks in hotels, lodging houses, laundries, ~~or~~ wash house or any other place as may be necessary, ~~or any~~

Section 2. In the event the owner or occupant of any property shall refuse or neglect to make any connection as provided for in section one of this ordinance, within the time specified in the notice, then it shall be the duty of the City of Payette to make the connection at the expense of the property owner or occupant and immediate suit shall be brought in any court of competent jurisdiction for the collection of the expenses and cost thereof, together with costs of suit.
