

ORDINANCE 184 BY E.C.S. BRAINARD.

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF THE OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, AND REPEALING ORDINANCES NUMBERS 143 and 148.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho.

Section 1. That the Mayor of the City of Payette, shall receive for his services, the sum of Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars per year, to be paid quarterly, and each Councilman shall receive for his services the sum of Five (\$5.00) Dollars for each session of the Council he attends. provided that no councilman shall receive or be allowed compensation for attending more than three sessions in any one month, or any compensation for any session at which he is not present for the entire session.

Section 2. The City Clerk, as such clerk, ex officio tax collector and Auditor, shall receive the sum of fifty (\$50.00) Dollars per month.

Section 3. The City Treasurer shall receive for his services the sum of Twenty Five (\$25.00) Dollars per annum, payable annually.

Section 4. The City Attorney shall receive for his services the sum of Thirty (\$30⁰⁰) Dollars per month, and the Police Judge shall receive for his services the sum of One Hundred (\$100⁰⁰) Dollars ~~per month~~ per year payable quarterly.

Section 5. The City Marshall, and other police officers, shall receive for their services such salaries as the City Council may from time to time determine by resolution.

Section 6. The City Engineer shall receive for his services the sum of One Hundred Fifty (\$150.00) Dollars per year, payable quarterly.

Section 7. Ordinance number 143 entitled an ordinance fixing the compensation of the Officers of the City of Payette, Idaho, and ordinance #148 entitled an amondment to Ordinance #143, are hereby repealed.

Section 8. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect on and after May 1st 1911.
