ORDINANCE NO. 187 BY

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING ~~TO~~ TO W. S. BRUNDAGE, THOMAS WALKER AND P. H. BROWN, THE RIGHT, PRIVILEGE AND AUTHORITY TO BUILD, OPERATE AND MAINTAIN <sup>A</sup> WATER PIPE LINE ALONG ~~THE~~ AND ACROSS CERTAIN PARTS OF <sup>*Seventh*</sup> ~~SIXTH~~ AVENUE NORTH.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette:

Section 1. That there is hereby granted to W. S. Brundage, Thomas Walker and P. H. Brown, their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, the right, privilege and authority to build, operate and maintain <sup>s</sup> ~~the~~ <sup>water</sup> water pipe line for the purpose of conveying and distributing <sup>water</sup> for irrigation and street sprinkling purposes only, to their lands within and contiguous to, the corporate limits of the City of Payette.

Section 2. The water pipe line herein mentioned and which the said W. S. Brundage, Thomas Walker and P. H. Brown are given the privilege and authority to build, operate and maintain and the location thereof is as follows: Beginning near the South line of <sup>*Seventh*</sup> ~~SIXTH~~ Avenue North, at the intersection of the same with the Lower Payette Ditch, East of the City limits on said avenue, thence West along the South side of said avenue approximately 1750 feet, to a point opposite the W. S. Brundage residence on said avenue; thence North across said avenue, with the privilege of making lateral connections for lands lying along the South side of said avenue and adjacent thereto. Said pipe line shall be placed under the ground at least two feet and shall be located near the curb line, the location to be under the direction of the <sup>*City Engineer*</sup> ~~Mayor and Council~~.

Section 3. The said pipe line shall be so constructed and maintained that the waters thereof shall not be allowed or permitted to flood the said street or avenue; and the said grantees shall forever save the City harmless from any and all damages that may be sustained by reason of the said pipe line or water system being run in and along said street or avenue.

Section 4. The size of the pipe ~~main~~ line to be laid under the

authority herein granted shall be of sufficient size to convey through the same an amount of water equal to 80 miner's inches measured by the standard rules of measurement, or any smaller size that grantees may desire to place therein; and in consideration of the granting of this privilege, the said W. S. Brundage, Thomas Walker and P. H. Brown *and their assigns* agree to give to the City of Payette any and all water it may desire when ~~said~~ the same shall or may be in said pipe line, for sprinkling or fire ~~purposes~~ protection ~~purposes~~.
