

ORDINANCE No. 193. by Burns.

An ORDINANCE REGULATING AUTOMOBILES AND MOTOR CYCLES IN THE CITY OF PAYETTE IDAHO. AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any owner, his agent or servants, or any other person or persons in the city of Payette, Idaho. to run an automobile or motor cycle on, over or across the streets or alleys of the City of Payette, without first having provided himself with a permit and tag as hereinafter set forth.

Section 2. It shall be the duty of the City Clerk to provide the said permits and tags, mentioned in Section 1. of this Ordinance, and on application therefor issue same to the persons persons applying therefor on payment to the City Clerk of the sum of \$5.00.

Each permit shall contain the name and number of the automobile or motor cycle, and tags so issued shall be consecutively numbered, and the number on the tag shall correspond with the number of the permit, which number can be used on such machine only.

Whenever any such vehicle shall be sold or transferred from one person to another, a new petition shall be filed with the City Clerk within Five days of such transfer, and upon the payment of a fee of One | \$1.00 | Dollar such vehicle shall be registered in the name of the new owner or owners.

Section 3. Every permit and tag so issued by the City Clerk shall shall be recorded in a book kept for that purpose showing the number of the permit and tag, name and number of vehicle, to whom the same was issued and the date thereof.

Section 4. The tag hereinbefore mentioned shall be of metal with raised letters and number thereon, four inches in height, and shall contain the word "PAYETTE", and the number. The said permits and tags shall be provided by the City Clerk and tags other than those so provided by him, will not be considered as complying with the provisions of the Ordinance.

Section 4: Continued. The permits so issued in addition to number, name and number of vehicle, name of the person to whom issued, and the date thereof, shall state the period for which the same is issued, which shall be for the life of the car of vehicle.

Every tag so issued to the owner of an automobile or motor cycle, shall be attached to the rear end of the vehicle in such a manner, that the number and letters thereon shall be conspicuously displayed. The said tag must be kept clean and in a condition that the letters and numbers thereon can be readily distinguished at all times.

Section 5 It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to run or drive any automobile or motor cycle across any street or alley in the City of Payette, at a greater rate of speed than ¹²~~ten~~ miles per hour, or turn any corner in the City of Payette, at a greater rate of speed than ⁸~~six~~ miles per hour. And it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to run or drive any automobile over or across or upon the streets or alleys of the City of Payette at night, without having attached to said automobile at least two burning lamps in front of said machine and one burning colored light in the rear of said machine, or one burning uncolored light in front of said motor cycle, said lights to be at all times in a serviceable condition and kept clean.

Section 6 Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not less than 500. and not more than \$100.00.
