ORDINANCE NO. 195 BY Burns

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 14 OF ORDINANCE NO. 166 OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette:

Section 1. That ~~xxx~~ Section 14 of Ordinance No. 166 of the City of Payette, ~~be~~ entitled "An ordinance to regulate the ~~passage~~ connection, alteration and repair of sewers and house drains in the City of Payette, Idaho, and providing a penalty for the violation thereof", passed by the Mayor and Council and approved by the Mayor of said City on the 8th day of August, 1910, be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

Section 14.

Every building shall be separately and independently connected with the sewer; provided, however, that when in the opinion of the City Engineer it is deemed advisable to connect two or more buildings or line of tenements with a main drain, each lateral to the main drain shall be considered as a separate connection, and shall terminate in a lamp hole not less than 10 inches in diameter, of sound vitrified sewer pipe, securely supported on a foundation of concrete, the joints to be properly cemented and the top covered with a metal cap sealed tight with cement.
