

ORDINANCE NO. 202 BY GORHAM.

An ordinance making the annual appropriation and levy for General, Road and Salary purposes, and Special Assessments for the redemption of outstanding Water Works, Water Works Extension and Sewer Bonds and the payment of interest on the same, and a special levy for the redemption of outstanding warrants and the payment of the accrued interest thereon.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette:

Section 1.

That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1911, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, the sum of 1-3/4 mills on each One Dollar of the assessed valuation of such property, and the funds realized from such levy, together with all licenses and fines, shall be placed in the General Fund of the City of Payette.

Section 2.

That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1911, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, the sum of 2-3/4 mills on each One Dollar of the assessed valuation of such property, and the funds realized from such levy shall be placed in the Salary Fund of the City of Payette.

Section 3.

That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the First Tuesday in May, 1911, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, the sum of 2-1/2 mills on each One Dollar of the assessed valuation of such property, and the funds realized from such levy shall be placed in the Road Fund of the City of Payette.

Section 4.

That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1911, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, a special assessment of 1-3/4 mills on each One Dollar of the assessed valuation of such property, and the funds realized from such levy shall be placed in the Water Works Bond Interest Fund and be expended in the payment of the interest on the \$30,000. Water Works Bonds heretofore issued by the said City of Payette.

Section 5.

That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1911, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, a special assessment of 1/4 mill on each One Dollar of the assessed valuation of such property, and the funds realized from such assessment shall be placed in the Water Works Bond Sinking Fund, which money shall be expended in paying the principal of the \$30,000. Municipal Water Works Bonds heretofore issued by the City of Payette, at the maturity thereof.

Section 6.

That there is hereby levied for the Fiscal Year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1911, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, a special assessment of 1/4 mill on each One Dollar of the assessed valuation of such property and the funds realized from such assessment shall be expended in the payment of the interest on the \$12,000. Sewer Bonds of the City of Payette.

Section 7.

That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1911, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, a special assessment of 1/8 of one mill on each One Dollar of the assessed valuation of such property, and the funds realized from such levy shall be placed in the Sewer Bond Sinking Fund and expended in the payment of the principal of the \$12,000. Sewer Bonds heretofore issued by the said City of Payette, as it comes due.

Section 8.

That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1911, against all the taxable property located within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, a special assessment of $\frac{1}{8}$ mill on each One Dollar of the assessed valuation of such property, and the funds realized from such levy shall be placed in the Water Works Extension Bond Interest Fund, and be expended in the payment of the interest of the \$12,000. Water Works Extension Bonds heretofore issued by the said City of Payette.

Section 9.

That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1911, against all the taxable property located within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, a special assessment of $\frac{1}{8}$ of one mill on each One Dollar of the assessed valuation of such property, and the funds realized from such levy shall be placed in the Water Works Extension Bond Sinking Fund and be expended in the payment of the principal of the \$12,000. Water Works Extension Bonds heretofore issued by the said City of Payette as it becomes due.

Section 10.

That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1911, against all of the taxable property located within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho, a special assessment of 2 mills on each One Dollar of the assessed valuation of such property, and the funds realized from such levy shall be used in the payment of outstanding warrants of the said city issued prior to May 1st., 1911, and interest thereon.

Section 11.

That the sum of \$4,000. is hereby appropriated for the General expenses for the fiscal year ending on the first Tuesday in May, 1912, and together with all licenses and fines and all other moneys not otherwise appropriated, shall become a part of the General Fund and be used to defray the general expenses of the City of Payette and any other expenses for which the General Fund may be used.

Section 12.

That the sum of \$5,000. is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year ending on the first Tuesday in May, 1912, for paying all salaries of all officers of the City of Payette, and the same shall constitute the Salary Fund for said purpose.

Section 13.

That the sum of \$7,500. is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year ending on the first Tuesday in May, 1912, for building and keeping in repair all roads and streets within the corporate limits of the said City of Payette, and together with all road taxes shall constitute and be, the Road Fund of the said city.

Section 14.

That the sum of \$1,604. is hereby appropriated from the moneys to be derived from the special taxes for the year 1911, for the payment of the interest on the \$30,000. Water Works Bonds and the same shall constitute a fund for that purpose.

Section 15.

That the sum of \$275. is hereby appropriated from the moneys to be derived from the special tax for the year 1911, for the redemption of Water Works Bonds and the same shall constitute a fund for that purpose.

Section 16.

That the sum of \$720. is hereby appropriated from moneys to be derived from special assessments for the year 1911, for the payment of interest on the \$12,000.00 sewer bonds, and the same shall constitute a fund for that purpose.

Section 17.

That the sum of \$200. is hereby appropriated from moneys to be derived from the special assessments for the year 1911, for the redemption of the \$12,000.00 sewer bonds at their maturity, and the same shall constitute a fund for that purpose.

Section 18.

That the sum of \$720. is hereby appropriated from the moneys to be derived from the special tax for the year 1911, for the payment of interest on the \$12,000.00 water works extension bonds, and the same shall constitute a fund for that purpose.

Section 19.

That the sum of \$200. is hereby appropriated from the moneys to be derived from the special tax for the year 1911, for the redemption of the \$12,000.00 water works extension bonds and the same shall constitute a fund for that purpose.

Section 20.

That the sum of \$2,500. is hereby appropriated from the moneys to be derived from the special tax for the year 1911, for the payment of all outstanding warrants issued by the said City of Payette, prior to May 1, 1911, together with the interest on the same.

On all streets running south from Center Ave., all even numbers shall be placed on the west side of said streets, and the odd numbers alternating shall be placed on the east side of said streets.

AN ORDINANCE MAKING THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION AND LEVY FOR GENERAL, ROAD AND SALARY PURPOSES AND SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS FOR THE REDEMPTION OF OUTSTANDING WATER WORKS, WATER WORKS EXTENSION AND SEWER BONDS AND THE PAYMENT OF INTEREST ON THE SAME AND A SPECIAL LEVY FOR THE REDEMPTION OF OUTSTANDING WARRANTS AND THE PAYMENT OF THE ACCRUED INTEREST THEREON.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette:

Section 1. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1911, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, the sum of 1-3/4 mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of such property, and the funds realized from such levy, together with all licenses and fines shall be placed in the General Fund of the City of Payette.

Section 2. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May 1911, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, the sum of 2-3/4 mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of ~~the~~ such property and the funds realized from such levy shall be placed in the Salary Fund of the City of Payette.

Section 3. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1911, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, the sum of ~~2x3~~ 2-1/4 mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of such property and the funds realized from such levy shall be placed in the Road Fund of the City of Payette.

Section 4. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1911, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, a special assessment of 1-3/4 mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of such property, and the funds realized from such levy shall be placed in the Water Works Bond Interest Fund and be expended in the payment of the interest on the \$30,000 Water Works Bonds heretofore issued by the said City of Payette.

Section 5. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing

ing on the first Tuesday in May, 1911, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, a special assessment of 1/4 mill on each one dollar of the ~~assessed~~ assessed valuation of such property, and the funds realized from such assessment shall be placed in the Water Works Bond Sinking Fund, which money shall be ~~used in~~ ~~paying the~~ expended in paying the principal of the \$30,000 municipal Water Works Bonds heretofore issued by the City of Payette, at the maturity thereof.

Section 6. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1911, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, a special assessment of 1/2 mill on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of such property and the funds realized from such assessment shall be expended in the payment of the interest in the \$12,000 sewer bonds of the City of Payette.

Section 7. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1911, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, a special assessment of 1/8 of one mill on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of such property and the funds realized from such levy shall be ~~expended in~~ ~~the~~ placed in the Sewer Bond Sinking Fund and expended in the payment of the principal of the \$12,000 Sewer Bonds heretofore issued by the said City of Payette, as it comes due.

Section 8. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1911, against all the taxable property located in the City of Payette, a special assessment of 1/2 mill on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of such property, and the funds realized from such levy shall be placed in the Water Works Extension Bond Interest Fund, and be expended in the payment of the interest on the \$12,000 Water Works Extension Bonds heretofore issued by the said City of Payette.

Section 9. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1911, against all the taxable property

located in the City of Payette, a special assessment of 1/8 of one mill on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of such property, and the funds realized from such levy shall be placed in the Water Works Extension Bond Sinking Fund and be expended in the payment of the principal of the \$12,000 Water Works Extension Bonds ~~as they~~ heretofore issued by said city as it becomes due.

Section 10. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1911, against all the taxable property located within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, a special assessment of 2 mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of such property and the funds realized from such levy shall be used in the payment of outstanding warrants of the said City ~~and interest thereon~~ issued prior to May 1st, 1911, and interest thereon.

Section 11. That the sum of \$4000.00 is hereby appropriated for the General Expenses for the fiscal year ~~terminating~~ ending on the first Tuesday in May, 1912 and together with all licenses and fines ~~shall~~ and all other moneys not otherwise appropriated, shall become a part of the General Fund and be used to defray the general expenses of the City of Payette and any other expenses for which the General Fund may be used.

Section 12. That the sum of \$5000. is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year ending on ~~May 1st~~ the first Tuesday in May, 1912, for paying all salaries of all officers of the City of Payette and the same shall constitute the Salary Fund for said purpose.

Section 13. That the sum of \$7500~~0~~ is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year ending on the first Tuesday in May, 1912, for building and keeping in repair all roads and streets within the corporate limits of the said City of Payette, and together with all road taxes shall constitute and be the Road Fund of the said City.

Section 14. That the sum of \$1604. is hereby appropriated from the moneys to be derived from the special taxes for the year 1911, for the payment of the interest on the \$30,000 Water Works Bonds, and the same shall constitute a fund for that purpose.

Section 15. That the sum of \$275.00 is hereby appropriated from the

moneys to be derived from the special tax for the year 1911, for the redemption of Water Works Bonds and the same shall constitute a fund for that purpose.

Section 16. That the sum of \$720. is hereby appropriated from moneys to be derived from special assessments for the year 1911, for the payment of interest on the \$12,000 Sewer Bonds, and the same shall constitute a fund for that purpose.

Section 17. That the sum of \$200.00 is hereby appropriated from moneys to be derived from the special ~~assessment~~ taxes for the year 1911, for the redemption of the \$12,000 Sewer Bonds at their maturity, and the same shall constitute a fund for that purpose.

Section 18. That the sum of \$720. is hereby appropriated from the moneys to be derived from the special tax for the year 1911, for the payment of interest on the \$12,000 Water Works Extension Bonds, and the same shall constitute a fund for that purpose.

Section 19. That the sum of \$200.00 is hereby appropriated from the moneys to be derived from the special tax for the year 1911, for the ~~payment~~ redemption of the \$12,000 Water Works Extension Bonds, and the same shall constitute a fund for that purpose.

Section 20. That the sum of \$2500.00 is hereby appropriated from the moneys to be derived from the special tax for the year 1911, for the payment of all outstanding warrants issued by the said City of Payette, prior to May 1st, 1911, together with interest on the same.
