

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A COMMITTEE FOR THE CARE, UPKEEP AND PROTECTION OF THE VARIOUS CITY PUBLIC BUILDINGS, ~~AND OF THE CITY MARSHALLS WITH REFERENCE TO PUBLIC BUILDINGS.~~ PRESCRIBING THE DUTIES OF SUCH COMMITTEE AND OF THE CITY MARSHALLS WITH REFERENCE TO PUBLIC BUILDINGS.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette.

Section 1. For the purpose of caring for, protecting, and the upkeep, repair and improvement of the various city buildings and grounds on which same are located, the Mayor shall, as soon after the passage, approval and publication of this ordinance, as conveniently may be done, appoint, with the approval of the Council, a committee, from among the Councilmen, consisting of three members, to be known as the "Public Buildings Committee", whose duties it shall be to have the full care, overseeing and general supervision, as well as the upkeep and protection of all public buildings of the city, ~~and the grounds on which same are located.~~ and the grounds on which all public buildings may be located. This Committee shall also have the assignment of the various rooms and offices to the various city officers, as well as the care and assignment of rooms for other public organizations and purposes, and shall perform such other duties as may be necessary for the proper care, protection, upkeep and repair of all public buildings and the grounds on which same may be located. Said committee shall hold office until its successors are appointed and qualified, or until such time as the members thereof shall cease to hold office as councilmen.

Section 2. It shall be the duty of the Day Marshall, ^{and} the Night Marshall, under instructions of the Day Marshall; under the supervision of the Public Buildings Committee, to see that the City Hall and Fire Stations are kept in a clean and sanitary condition, properly swept and kept free from dust and rubbish at all times, and that the lighting, heating and sanitary conditions of the same are kept in proper shape, under directions of the ~~Public Buildings Committee.~~

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official newspaper.

Section 4. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
