

Ordinance No. 240 by Mr. Peterson

An Ordinance giving notice of the intention to create a Local Improvement District, to be known as Local ^{Sidewalk-Curbing} Improvement ^{No. 1} of the City of Payette, Idaho.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho.

Section 1. That notice is hereby given that it is the intention of the City of Payette, Idaho, by its Mayor and Council, to create a local improvement district to be known as Local ^{Sidewalk-Curbing} Improvement ^{No. 1} District of the City of Payette, for the purpose of building sidewalks and placing curbing within the territory embraced within said District, to-wit;

Section 2. The estimated costs for sidewalks within said District is 10 cents per square foot; and the estimated expense for curbing is 35 cents per lineal foot; such costs to be taxed against the property abutting, fronting, contiguous and tributary; provided; the expense of all improvements in the space formed by the junction of two or more streets, or where in one main street terminates in, or crosses another main street, and also street crossings or cross walks, shall be paid by the City of Payette.

Section 3. All persons interested within said proposed Local Improvement District are hereby notified that he or she may protest against the forming of such local Improvement District, by filing their protests with the City Clerk of said City, at his office in the City Hall in the City of Payette, on or before 7 o'clock P.
