

- ORDINANCE No. 248.
Introduced by Mr. I. L. Thurston.

An ordinance to regulate the riding of Bicycles and Tri-cycles within the City of Payette, Idaho, and to provide a penalty for the violation thereof, and to repeal ~~all~~ parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to ride a bicycle or tri-cycle on any sidewalk or the parking between the roadway and the sidewalk on eighth street between First Ave. south and Second Ave North and on Central Ave between Sixth and Ninth Streets, ~~West side of 7th Street~~, East side of 7th, Street between 2nd, Ave North and 1st, Ave South; West side of 9th, street between 2nd Ave North and 1st, Ave South, and on 1st Ave South between 9th, Street and 6th, street; and 2nd Ave North between 9th, street and 6th street; and 1st Ave North between 9th, street and 6th street

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to ride any bicycle or tricycle on any sidewalk or footpath within the City of Payette, at a greater speed than 8 miles an hour; and it shall be unlawful for any person to ride a bicycle or tricycle on any of the public streets of said City, at a greater speed than ten miles an hour.

Section 3. It shall be unlawful for any person to ride a bicycle ~~on~~ ~~within~~ within the corporate limits of said City, unless the same is provided with a bell; or to ride a bicycle or tricycle in said city after dark unless said vehicle shall have attached thereon, and to some conspicuous portion of the front thereof, a lighted lantern or lamp.

Section 4. No person shall ride any bicycle or tricycle on any of the streets of said City, unless said person shall have procured a license to ride on the sidewalks as provided herein.

Section 5. Before being permitted to ride on any of the ~~streets~~ of said City, a license therefor shall be procured from the City Clerk of said City which said license shall be issued on the payment of the sum of \$1.00; provided that no such license shall be issued to any person under the age of ten years, such license shall be in force for the period of one year unless sooner revoked.

Section 6. It shall be unlawful for any person ~~to~~ riding a bicycle to approach nearer than fifty feet to any person walking on any sidewalk or footpath, unless such rider shall, not less than fifty feet or more than one hundred feet from such person sound a signal with the bell on said bicycle.

Section 7. No person shall be permitted to ride either a bicycle or tricycle on any sidewalks of said City, except at such times as the city streets are so muddy from rain or snow as to render such streets impossible for use of either bicycle or tricycle.

Section 8. It shall be unlawful to ride a bicycle or tricycle on any sidewalk within said city past any person, but it shall be the duty of such rider to dismount at least ten feet from such person.

Section 9. It shall be unlawful for any person riding such a sidewalk or footpath within the said city, to pass any street or alley intersecting said sidewalk or footpath, without sounding an alarm upon a bicycle bell, at a point more than fifty feet from the corner of such intersection.

Section 10. Any person violation any of the provisions of this ordinance shall on conviction thereof, be fined in any sum not less than \$1.00, nor more than \$25.00, and the license therefor shall be revoked on the second offense.

Section 11. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance ~~with~~ ~~in~~ in conflict with the provisions with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 12. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication.
