

ORDINANCE No. 250

ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE PEDDLING OR SALE OF FRUITS AND VEGETABLES ^{or} ~~merchandise of any kind~~ ON THE RIGHT OF WAY OF THE OREGON SHORT LINE RAILWAY COMPANY WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, AND TO PROVIDE PENALTIES THEREFOR.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to sell, or offer for sale, on the right-of-way of the Oregon Short Line Railway within the limits of the City of Payette, Idaho, any fruits or vegetables of any kind or description. ~~or merchandise of any kind~~

Section 2. Any person violating the provisions of Section 1, of this ordinance, shall, on conviction thereof, pay a fine of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$25.00, and costs of prosecution, and shall stand committed until such fine is paid.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication.
