

ORDINANCE No. 251
INTRODUCED BY Mr. Fulton

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE COLLECTION OF TAXES AND SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho.
Section 1. It shall be the duty of the City Clerk as ex-officio tax collector of the City of Payette, Idaho, to collect all taxes and special assessments levied and assessed by the Mayor and Council of said City, as provided by section 2365 of the Codes of the State of Idaho.

Section 2. All taxes and special assessments of such City, levied and assessed by the Mayor and Council, shall mature and become due and payable as provided in section 2365, of the Codes of the State of Idaho; and if any such levy and assessment shall become delinquent for a period of twenty (20) ^{days} after the same shall become due and payable, it shall be the duty of such tax collector to add to, and collect the sum of ten per cent of the amount of such tax or assessment, as a penalty for such delinquency as provided in section 1742 of the Codes of the State of Idaho.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication.
