

ORDINANCE No. 254

Introduced by Mr. Crighton

An ordinance in relation to the blockading of street crossings by railroad cars or trains.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Counsel of the City of Payette, Idaho
Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any railroad operating within the limits of the City of Payette, Idaho, to let any of its cars or trains of cars, stand or remain on any street crossed by such railroad, for a longer period of time than ~~three~~ ^{five} (5) minutes from the time of the stepping of such car or train of cars, at any time, either night or day.

Section 2. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance, shall on conviction thereof, be fined in any sum not less than \$25.00, nor more than \$100.00, and shall stand committed to the jail of said City, until such fine is paid.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication.
