

ORDINANCE NO. 255 BY GORHAM.

AN ORDINANCE GIVING NOTICE OF THE INTENTION TO AMEND SECTION 1, OF ORDINANCE No. 154 CREATING LOCAL SEWER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 1, OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, BY ADDING TO, AND INCORPORATING IN SAID SEWER DISTRICT CERTAIN ADDITIONAL TERRITORY IN SAID CITY.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section 1.

That it is proposed to amend Section 1 of Ordinance No. 154, creating Local Sewer Improvement District No. 1, by adding to said Improvement District the following territory, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the center line of Eleventh Street 37.5 feet east and 16 feet south of the south-east corner of Block 5, Park addition and running thence south to the center line of the alley through Block 5, Jacobson's addition, thence east 1150 feet to the center line of Fourteenth street, thence south to the center line of Center Avenue, thence west 1232.5 feet to a point 15 feet east and 50 feet south of the southeast corner of Block 16, Gorrie's Addition, thence north to a point on the north line of Gorries addition, thence east to the place of beginning. Also, Beginning at the intersection of Center Avenue and 14th streets and running thence south along the center of 14th street to the center of the alley through Block 26 of Melcher's addition, thence east along the center of said alley to the west of the right-of-way of the Lower Payette Ditch., thence northerly along said right-of-way to the center line of Center Avenue, thence west to the point of beginning.

Section 2.

That the cost of and expense of said proposed additions to said sewer improvement district will be taxed against all the property in said addition abutting on the streets and parts of streets, lots and parcels of land lying and being within the boundaries of said proposed additions to said Sewer Improvement District No. 1, as set forth in Section No. 1 of this Ordinance, and that the estimated expenses of said additions to said improvement will not exceed the sum of \$1.25 per lineal foot of the frontage of each lot and parcel of land in said addition abutting contiguous or tributary to said streets and parts of streets.

Section 3.

That all owners of property fronting on the streets and parts of streets being within said proposed additions to said Sewer Improvement District No. 1, are hereby notified that any and all protests that they may have and desire to make against the proposed additions to said Improvement District, may be filed in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Payette on or before the 6th day of July, 1914.

Section 4.

That the expenses of all improvements in such additions in spaces formed by the junction of all streets and all necessary streets and alley crossings in making such proposed additions shall be paid by the City of Payette.

the City Clerk shall give notice by three successive publications in the official newspaper of the City; that such assessment roll is on file in his office, the date of filing same, and such notice shall state a time at which the council will hear and consider objections to said assessment roll by the parties aggrieved by such assessments. And the owner or owners of any property which is assessed in such assessment roll, whether named or not in such roll, may within ten days from the last publication provided herein, file with the City Clerk, his objections in writing to said assessment. Section 6.

At the time appointed for hearing objections to such assessments, the council shall hear, and determine all objections which have been filed by any party interested to the regularity of the proceedings in making such assessments and the correctness of such assessments, or of the amount levied on any particular lot or parcel of land; and the council shall have the power to adjourn such hearing from time to time and shall have power, in their discretion, to revise, correct, confirm or set aside such assessment and to order that such assessment be made de novo, and the council shall make an order approving and confirming said assessment by them, and their decision and order shall be a final determination of the regularity, validity and correctness of said assessment to the amount thereof levied on each lot and parcel of land. All such assessments shall be known as "Special Assessments for Improvements" and shall be levied and collected as a special tax in addition to the taxes for general revenue purposes to be placed on the tax roll for collection, subject to the same penalties, and collected in the same manner as other city taxes. Section 7.

The sprinkling committee shall not increase the area sprinkled for the season of 1912, except upon the petition of residents of that street or part of street or streets which such sprinkling affects, which petition shall be favorably acted upon by the Council of the City of Payette. Section 8.

Ordinances Nos. 95 and 203 of the City of Payette and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed in so far as they conflict therewith.
