ORDINANCE NO. 26.

An ordinance relating to planting of shade trees in the city of Payette .

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette.

Section I. That along all streets one hundred feet in width, trees shall be planted twenty-three feet from the building line; along all streets eighty feet in width, trees shall be planted fourteen feet from the building line; along all streets seventy-five feet in width, trees shall be planted thirteen feet from the building line; and along all streets fifty feet in width, trees shall be planted ten feet from the building line.

Section II. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined in a sum not less than five dollars and not more than twenty-five dollars, and an additional sum of five dollars for every forty-eight hours that said trees shall remain planted in any other manner than prescribed in this ordinance, after notice to remove the same by the city marshal.

Section III. All ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
