ORDINANCE No. 766

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 1, OF ORDINANCE No. 145 OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE? ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING A LICENSE TAX FROM POP CORN, CONFECTIONARY AND PEA ~~NOT~~ VENDORS; AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE. *and to repeal said original section 1.*

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho

Section 1. That Section 1, of Ordinance No. 145, be and the same be amended to read as follows:

Section 1. It shall be and hereby is made unlawful for any person, firm or association, to engage in selling pea nuts, confectionary and pop corn or either, on any street, alley, avenue, sidewalk, theater, or other public places within the City of Payette, Idaho, without first obtaining a license from the said City of Payette, Idaho, and each and every person who engages in the vending of either pea nuts, pop corn or confectionary, within the said City of Payette, Idaho, shall pay a quarterly license to the said City of Payette, in the sum of Five Dollars per quarter.

Section 2. That said Section 1, of Ordinance No. 145, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication.

The city council of the city of Payette, in the state of Idaho, met in regular session at the city hall in said city, on Monday, the 19th day of April A. D. 1915, at 8 o'clock P. M., pursuant to the rules of said council.

The mayor, C. B. Compton, called the meeting to order, and upon roll call it was found that the following councilmen were present: F. E. Euston, Chas. Smith, L. E. Peterson, R. L. Shaw, Chas. Fulton and S. A. Gorham

Thereupon, Councilman Peterson introduced an ordinance entitled:

"An Ordinance confirming the creation and establishment of Local Sidewalk and Curb Improvement District No. 1, in the city of Payette; approving the assessment roll for said district as filed in the office of the city clerk and confirmed by the council on the 22nd day of September, A. D. 1914, providing for the payment by installments of the costs and expenses of the improvements made in said district; providing for the issue of improvement bonds of the district; assessing the cost of the said improvements against the lots, blocks and parcels of land in said district contiguous to, fronting or abutting upon said improvements; and describing the manner for the collection and payment of said assessments;" which ordinance was thereupon read in full and is as follows:
